- Penning Protocol:** To be completed by anyone bringing Alpacas for competition. This can be found on the entry form.
- Health Declaration:** To be completed by anyone bringing Alpacas for competition.
- Entry Fees:** \$10.00 per entrant for all classes* (includes Showmanship and Stockmanship).
- Age of Exhibit:** Age of competitor and animals* will be calculated as at 29th Sept.
- Entries to include:** Payment, Entry Form and Health Declaration.

Companion animals and dogs:

Special permission to bring a companion alpaca must be obtained from the Convenor prior to submission of the entry form, otherwise no companion alpacas will be permitted. No dogs are permitted into the precinct of where Show animals are being penned or shown in the ring. Guide Dogs and registered Assistance Dogs are exempt.

Penning Protocol and Health Declarations are only needed if you are bringing alpacas. If you are having alpacas supplied for you, you do not need these forms.
