



## FLOCK OF THE YEAR EVENT REGULATIONS

1.	The Competition is open to any person, partnership or company provided always, that the sheep exhibited are the bona fide property of that person, partnership or company and located in the area defined.
2.	The competition is open to all properties located in the Bendigo, Serpentine and Ballarat areas.
3.	The sheep to be exhibited must have been running on a property of the entrant for the full previous twelve months and must carry the registered PIC of the entrant.
4.	Competition is restricted to commercial sheep and, as such, sheep must not be registered with Victoria Stud Merino Sheep Breeders Association.
5.	Judges will take into account the varying seasonal conditions found throughout the region when judging.
6.	Each exhibitor will be required to exhibit their maiden ewes. The percentage of ewes classed may be indicated on the exhibitor's entry form.
7.	Each exhibitor is requested to display a minimum of 200 ewes.
8.	Each exhibitor will be required to exhibit at least the normal number of sires used to join the ewes entered in the Competition.
9.	Lambing and weaning percentages of ewes joined maybe indicated on the exhibitor's entry form.
10.	Judging will be conducted on 14 and 15 March 2018.
11.	All properties adjoining the region's boundaries are eligible. Please contact RASV if you are uncertain of the competition boundaries.
12.	An overall winner for the region will be announced on Thursday 15 March 2018. The Judges' decision is final.
13.	Buses and cars may visit the properties for judging.
14.	In the event of adverse weather conditions, the RASV's decision is final.
15.	The entry fee will be \$100 per exhibitor (incl GST), payable to The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria upon entry. RASV Members pay an entry fee of \$80 per exhibitor (incl GST).
16.	Decisions by the Committee regarding the boundaries, eligibility and the location of the sheep for inspection will be final.
17.	A winner will be chosen from the region. The winner will be awarded a \$1,500 cash prize, a plaque, and be profiled in regional media publications.
