## Enter the 2010 GENETICS AUSTRALIA SHARE DAIRY FARMER AWARDS

**First Prize** The title of 2010 Genetics Australia Share Dairy Farmer of the Year, semen package to the value of \$3,300 and a plaque.

**Second Prize** Semen package to the value of \$2,000 and a plaque.

**Third Prize** Semen package to the value of \$1,100 and a plaque.

Five other trophies are awarded to the state finalists. For the purpose of the competition, the state is divided into six zones, covering the share farming community as equally as possible. Each zone winner will receive semen packages to the value of \$700.

The competition is open to Share Dairy Farmers farming in Australia within the state of Victoria and the Riverina district of New South Wales.

## 2010 Genetics Australia Share Dairy Farmer Awards objectives

- Reward top sharefarmers for their contribution to productivity.
- Encourage young farmers to enter the dairy industry.
- Extend the performance of the top sharefarmers to others.
- Raise the profile of the sharefarming profession.
- Encourage a good relationship between the sharefarmer and owner.

## Conditions of Entry

1) The rules appearing in these conditions of entry form part of the General Regulations to this event. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these rules, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise. 2) The competition is open to all sharefarmers in Victoria and the Riverina region of southern New South Wales, provided that the cattle on the farm are the bona fide property of the sharefarmer or the farm owner. All entries must be signed by the

sharefarmer and endorsed by the farm owner. The sharefarmer and the farm owner must have been operating together for at least two years. Son or daughter sharefarmers are eligible to enter provided there is a written agreement between the sharefarmer and the farm owner.

3) Herds may be of any breed, mixed or cross, stud or commercial.

4) The award will be judged on the following criteria:

| • Sharefarmer-Owner relationship               | 10 points |

| • Family and leisure time                      | 7 points  |
| • Community affairs and off-farm interest      | 7 points  |

5) Entries close on Friday 11 June 2010. Forward your entry to: Genetics Australia Share Dairy Farmer Awards, The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited, Melbourne Showgrounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale VIC 3032.

6) A panel of at least three judges will be arranged for each zone.

7) Key dates:

- Zone judging will take place between Monday 21 June and Friday 16 July 2010.

- Zone judges will be required to select the Champion Zone Sharefarmer on or before Friday 16 July 2010.

- State Judging will take place in the week commencing Monday 26 July 2010.

- The winner will be announced at the Share Dairy Farmer Awards Presentation during the 2010 Royal Melbourne Dairy Show.

8) State judges will be appointed through consultation between The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited and Genetics Australia Co-operative Limited.
